



- **1. Consumer Price Index** CPI in Czech Republic is expected to be 149.85 points by the end of this quarter
- HIGH Inflation 11% causes the destruction of consumer demand pressures = the drop in consumption in our country is the largest of all EU countries. However on declining curve.
- Currency CZK:EUR STRONGER Czech Crown YOY +9% limit competitiveness of Czech producers in Export Markets, May slight weakening
- 3. Material and energy and personal cost increases Producers are dealing with too high YOY production cost increases, combined with later time shift to get money from customers by price increases activities

Specific developments in customer industries

- Overstocking in consumer channels from last year demand (fear of long delivery time) causes still low orders (all sectors)
- Impact of world geopolitical situation
 - Agriculture announcement decline in industry Min from 4Q/23 2Q/24
 - Industrial Machines postponed investments, more repair, refurbishments
 - Defence sector only Booming
- Fatigue of personal After 3 years of society paradigm changes (2 years COVID and last year war in Europe) we can observe moral and physical employee fatigue

Supply chain and delivery time situation

- Shortage of electronic components and their price increase continues
- Transport costs and lack of personal in transport companies = Improvements

Country strategy and trends emerged as reaction of past year's events

2023 Energy (elektricity + Gas) SPOT Prices - The government has approved a
regulation that sets the rules for SPOT energy prices. It will help with high electricity
and gas prices not only for households, but also for small and medium-sized
businesses.
